- Very good writing skills (this will take 70-80% of the work);

- Problem-solving mindset and teamwork spirit;
- A team player, proactive, able to work independently and demonstrate initiative;
- Aptitude for using your technical knowledge creatively to address new challenges;
- Appropriate accuracy and attention to detail;
- Excellent interpersonal skills and strongly motivated to continue learning;
- Organisation and time-management skills;
- Flexibility, enthusiasm for new challenges and strong willingness for learning and growth';
- Willingness to travel overseas occasionally on short-term (e.g. between 2 to 10 days) assignments up to circa 3-4 times per year;

## Your role

The primary focus of your role will be to contribute to project delivery regarding all aspects of climate change planning processes at international level.
